Extra Charges - IMPORTANT

Extra Charges will apply for the following items/material, due to the difficult nature of their recycling and disposal by Resource Facilities. Charges will be automatically charged to you if found in the skip but not declared.

* Carpet / Underlay and Astro Turf \$30 per m³

For the whole bin. I.e., \$300 extra for 10m³ of bin size.

- * Mattresses (per mattress) \$80
- * Tyres (per tyre) \$30 \$60
 Depending on size and on or off rim ask the office for guidelines if you would like to dispose of tyres.
- * Oversized concrete/stone pieces up to \$85 each. (Greater than 1m x 1m x 100mm)
- * Stumps \$70 per m³ (greater than 30cm diameter & or more than 80cm in length, charges will apply depending on size)
- * Palm Material \$15 per m³ (Fronds & Stems Only - Stumps will be charged at the above price)
- * Wasted trip (Starting at \$50, depending on area and distance. For example if cars parked in front of skip and unable to shift.



- * Reload Contaminated Skip at Tip Site \$180
- Disposal of hazardous contaminated skips \$200 m3 in addition to original cost

Any damage incurred whilst the skip is under hire (i.e.: Fire or physical damage – etc.) will incur additional charges at the discretion of management

General Waste

General is classed as household waste that can break down such as: wood, paper/cardboard, furniture, some metal, household/domestic items, green waste etc.

Mixed / Heavy Waste

Sand, bricks, rocks, tiles, concrete, plaster, pavers, dirt, soil, turf.

No wet cement Skip bin must be filled with at least 50% heavy waste

Hire Period

The price quoted covers a hire period of 1 - 7 days. Should you wish for a longer hire period, please contact the office, and arrange 24hrs prior to the scheduled pick up.

Loading a Skip

When filling a skip do not overload it. Waste must not be filled past the top of the bin and the rubbish must be fully within the skip with no protrusions outside of bin, should the skip be overloaded, and our driver cannot collect it, you will be charged a wasted trip fee and will be required to repack the skip.

Hazardous Waste

Is <u>not</u> accepted. This includes asbestos, gas bottles, batteries, liquids and flammables such as paint, oils, chemicals and pesticides. No silica based artificial stone.

Full bins of asbestos: please contact office for Asbestos skip charges and procedures involved. Regulations must be strictly adhered to - or the bin will not be collected. You may be required to repack and re-tape the asbestos as per Department of Environment Regulations. Heavy fines and charges will apply.

* Should any asbestos be mixed in a skip and our driver is made to reload the skip, you will be charged with a reload fee and contaminated waste

<u>Items NOT Accepted (unless approved and noted by our office staff)</u>

- * No Large amounts of glass
- * Mattresses and Tyres
- * Carpet/underlay/Astro Turf
- Super 6/ HardiFence/ Villaboard / Cement Fencing material

Skip Bin Delivery / Pick Up

We will, to the best of our ability, place the skip bin where you would like it. We cannot place bins on the road or footpath without a council permit. For narrow spaces, our trucks require a minimum of 3m wide space to reduce the risk of damage to the truck and the customer's property.

* Do not move the skip from its delivery position!! *

DISCLAIMER

All care is taken by our drivers to ensure the delivery and collection of the skip is carried out safely. However, **Kwik Skips will not be held accountable for any damage caused to your property** where the driver has adhered to the customer's instructions.

Heavy bins will almost always mark a driveway in some way, truck tyres can depress and crack pavers and kerbing. For the skip to be delivered onto the driveway, there is always the chance of it being scratched as the skip bins have angular feet. We suggest new driveways or larger skips, the customer placing timber planks down first or put it on the grass, Kwik Skips do not supply these.
